Project objective:

The project aims to support the provision of sustainable and efficient rural electrification service for more than 40 low-income rural households, contributing to the reduction of CO2 emissions, and to the fight against deforestation.

In addition, the project foresees a capacity building programme focused on different areas of sustainability. More than 60 indigenous people including women will benefit for the programme.

Project status: on-going

- 01** The project started in the last quarter of 2019.
- 02** The project was presented to the beneficiaries in the communities to ensure full understating of the activities and guarantee support and participation.
- 03** 20 community leaders participated in 2 3-day practical trainings on good environmental practices.
- 04** Construction and installation of 30 eco-efficient stoves was initiated and will have positive impact on environment and health of the community.

- 05** 40 semi-illiterate women and men were trained in solar panel system installation and maintenance.
